Resolution authorizing the City Manager, or designee, to leasepurchase a valve maintenance trailer for the Utilities Department from E. H. Wachs Utility Products, a division of ITW, of Harvard, Illinois, based on a sole source for a total amount not to exceed \$82,280.21; and finding that the purchase of the valve maintenance trailer is necessary to preserve and protect the public health and safety of the City's residents.

WHEREAS, one valve maintenance trailer will be lease-purchased for use by the Utilities Department;

WHEREAS, this valve maintenance trailer will assist water crews in the operation, opening and closing of water valve throughout the City;

WHEREAS, State law provides that such procurements, as outlined above, are subject to statutory procurement requirements, including competitive bids, unless an exception applies;

WHEREAS, there is also a statutory exception for this procurement in Local Government Code, Section 252.022(a)(7)(A), as this purchase is available from only one source due to special processes or patents.

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Corpus Christi, Texas:

Section 1. The City Council specifically finds that the foregoing statements included in the preamble of this resolution are true and correct and adopts such findings for all intents and purposes related to the authorization of this procurement.

Section 2. The City Manager, or her designee, is authorized to lease-purchase a valve maintenance trailer by the Utilities Department from E. H. Wachs Utility Products, a division of ITW, Harvard, Illinois, based on a sole source for a total amount not to exceed \$82,280.21.
