Accepting and appropriating the HIDTA grant subaward for the Police Department

CAPTION:

Ordinance authorizing the City Manager or designee to execute all documents necessary to accept a grant subaward in the amount of \$20,000 from the Executive Office of the President, Office of National Drug Control Policy, to support the Police Department's role in the Texas Coastal Corridor Initiative in the Houston High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) for additional overtime in an effort to eradicate the synthetic cannabinoid epidemic; and appropriating the \$20,000 in the No. 1061 Police Grants Fund.

PURPOSE:

The grant award needs to be accepted and the funds appropriated.

BACKGROUND AND FINDINGS:

The Corpus Christi Police Department is in the 21st year as a participant in the Texas Coastal Corridor High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area Initiative created by the Executive Office of the President, Office of National Drug Control Policy. The grant subaward provides for overtime in an effort to eradicate the synthetic cannabinoid. The funds are available through the end of the grant 12/31/2017.
