Service Agreement Current Value: Contingency contract; by task order (RFP BI-0167-13)

The City of Corpus Christi ("City") and **CrowderGulf, LLC** ("Contractor") entered into the above-referenced agreement ("Agreement") and now desire to mutually execute this amendment ("Amendment No. 1") in order to put into effect the modifications or revisions stated in this instrument, which, by execution below and taken together with the Agreement and all other executed amendments, if any, constitutes the entire understanding and agreement between the parties.

- (A) This Amendment No. 1 modifies the Agreement as follows:
 - 1. A rate of \$2.50 per cubic yard for loading and transporting mulch to final disposal within the City of Corpus Christi, based on reduced material outgoing to final disposal, is added to the fee schedule.
 - 2. A task order for loading and transporting mulch to final disposal, at the rate set out in (A)(1) of this Amendment No. 1, is authorized in an amount up to and not exceeding \$236,875. The task order is effective upon issuance of a notice to proceed signed by the Contract Administrator.

The terms and conditions of the Agreement not modified or revised by this Amendment No. 1 remain in full force and effect for all intents and purposes of the parties. Upon execution, this Amendment No. 1 supplements the Agreement and is incorporated by reference into the Agreement as if fully set out in its entirety in the Agreement.
