Resolution authorizing the City Manager or designee to execute a Second Amendment to the Reformed Cooperative Agreement between the City of Corpus Christi and the County of Nueces County, Texas to Operate a Public Health District, to provide for additional cost-shares of expenditures from the County to the City.

WHEREAS, the City of Corpus Christi and Nueces County, Texas previously entered into an Agreement effective April 21, 2009 to cooperatively operate a public health district for the benefit of both parties ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, a First Amendment to the Reformed Cooperative Agreement was approved by City Council on August 21, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the City and County need to amend the Agreement again to provide for a cost sharing formula to allocate the annual cost of a Buyer position and Information Technology Services for the Public Health District; and

WHEREAS, the Second Amendment to the Reformed Cooperative Agreement is hereby presented to the City Council for review and approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the City Manager or designee is authorized to execute the Second Amendment to the Reformed Cooperative Agreement between Corpus Christi, Texas and the County of Nueces, Texas to Operate a Public Health District. A copy of the Second Amendment is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force immediately after its adoption by the City Council.
