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Status Update #1

Recommendation #1 – Coordinated Entry

- The Salvation Army will be only Entry Point
 - Referral source for all Social Service Agencies in the Community
- Components to be followed:
 - All households will receive a mini-assessment – Housing Crisis
 - Eligible households will receive a full assessment and meet with Caseworker.
 - A Universal Assessment Tool will be used by a variety of agencies with households entering their agency seeking emergency shelter or homeless prevention services.

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Status Update #4

Recommendation #4 – Family Reunification Program

- The Salvation Army will be the service agency undertaking activity.
 - Referral source for all Social Service agencies in the Community
- Shelter Diversion Program – Existing TSA Program
- Reunification activity will fall within overall Shelter Diversion Program
- Pilot Program
 - Measure: Families entering diversion program and reunited outside Corpus Christi
