





Location Map





Vicinity Map



Schanen Ditch Hike & Bike Trail (Phase 4)






Vicinity Map

TASAP Nominations




- Schanen Hike & Bike Trail (Phase 4)
 - Continue northern extension of Hike & Bike Trail (Killarmet Dr. to Holly Rd.)


- Dr. Hector P. Garcia Park (Airport Ditch) Hike & Bike Trail (Phase 2)

TASAP




- Grant administered by the CCMPO
 - Distributes Federal transportation funds
 - Local implementation through TxDOT oversight
- Grant goals change for every cycle
- History
 - City has applied previously and received award funding
 - City has previously used the grant awards for hike and bike trails, Bicycle Boulevard wayfinding initiative, high intensity activated crosswalk.



Eligible projects include:

1. Construction and design of on-and-off road pedestrian and bicycle facilities
2. Construction and design of infrastructure projects to improve safe routes for non drivers
3. Construction and design of pedestrian and bicycle infrastructure to improve the ability of students to bike and walk to school
4. Conversion and use of abandoned railroad corridors for trails for pedestrians, bicyclists or other non-motorized transportation user
