

BOARD DETAILS



The Port of Corpus Christi Authority of Nueces County, Texas follows the laws prescribed in Article XVI, Section 59 of the Texas Constitution.



COMPOSITION

Seven (7) members appointed as follows: three (3) City Council, three (3) Nueces County Commissioner's Court and one (1) San Patricio County for three-year staggered terms. Each person who is appointed or elected shall be a resident of the proposed navigation district and shall be an elector of the county. A person must have been a resident of Nueces County for at least six months to be eligible for appointment to the Port Commission. Commissioners may serve up to four (4) three-year terms.






