**WHEREAS**, COBRA/CYMI JV failed to demonstrate the experience and qualifications specified in the bid documents.

**SECTION 1.** The apparent low bid submitted by COBRA/CYMI JV is rejected as non-responsive.

The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute a construction contract with CSA Construction, Inc. of Houston, Texas as the lowest responsive, responsible bidder in the amount of \$22,865,540 for the Oso Water Reclamation Plant Headworks and Lift Station project for the Total Base Bid plus Additive Alternate No. 1.
