Resolution adopting the City's Guidelines and Criteria for Granting Tax Abatements.

PURPOSE:

Approve the tax abatement guidelines for the City of Corpus Christi.

BACKGROUND AND FINDINGS:

Tax abatement is an incentive where companies for a certain amount of investment and jobs can apply for property tax abatement for City property tax over a period of time. The State statute limits this time to ten years. The guidelines delineate the amount of investment required and the average salary requirements to get a specific level of tax abatement.
