Acceptance of the IMM/LOCALS Immunization Branch-Locals Grant and Grant Program Income in the amount of \$311,637.00, and appropriation of the funds for the contract period September 1, 2018 through August 31, 2019.

CAPTION:

Ordinance accepting grant from the Texas Department of State Health Services for the Immunization/Locals Grant Program in the amount of \$241,637.00 and appropriating \$70,000.00 in estimated program income.

PURPOSE:

To be used to provide for personnel costs, supplies and other expenses to provide immunizations to eligible children, adolescents, and adults, with special emphasis on children three years of age or younger to stop vaccine preventable diseases from occurring in the population of the State of Texas.

BACKGROUND AND FINDINGS:

The Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) has awarded a grant in the amount of \$241,637.00 to provide for personnel costs, supplies and other expenses to provide immunizations to eligible children, adolescents, and adults, with special emphasis on children three years of age or younger to stop vaccine preventable diseases from occurring in the population of the State of Texas.

ALTERNATIVES:

Refuse the grant and discontinue providing immunizations to the population of the State of Texas.

Comments:

The grant does not require a cash or in-kind match by the City. The Department of State Health Services ("DSHS") allows the Health Department to charge fees to administer vaccines provided by the grant; however, any fees collected during each month of the grant must be deducted from each monthly grant reimbursement request made to DSHS. Annual grant program fees are estimated to be \$70,000 that have been included in the FY2017-2018 Health Department Budget.
