### **CAPTION:**

Motion to de-obligate \$202,771.95 from the Small Business Projects to the Type A Fund 1140 for 2017

#### **PURPOSE:**

De-obligate funds from the small business projects and return to the Type A fund 1140.

#### **BACKGROUND AND FINDINGS:**

The Board approved a motion to provide LiftFund \$250,000 grant for micro-lending, Texas A&M University-Corpus Christi \$150,000 and Del Mar College \$150,000 for their internship programs. The three programs had balances shown below at the end of the fiscal year. These balances cannot be rolled forward and can be de-obligated and returned to the Type A general fund for other uses at the Board's discretion.
