Resolution designating the Mother Teresa Shelter in Corpus Christi as the subrecipient of Homeless Housing and Services Program funds from the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs for 2019 and 2020.

**WHEREAS**, the State of Texas provides Homeless Housing and Services Program (HHSP) funds to municipalities with populations of 285,500 or greater; and

**SECTION 1.** The City of Corpus Christi designates the Mother Teresa Shelter of Corpus Christi, Texas to be the subrecipient of HHSP funds from the TDHCA for the 2019 and 2020 funding years.
