**Interlocal Cooperation Agreement (ILA)**  
With Texas A&M University – Corpus Christi (TAMUCC)  
Aesthetic Column Painting on Ennis Joslin Road

**CAPTION:**

Resolution authorizing execution of an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement (ILA) with Texas A&M University – Corpus Christi (TAMUCC) for aesthetic column painting on Ennis Joslin Road.

**PURPOSE:**

This ILA documents the terms of an agreement between TAMUCC and the City for aesthetic column painting on Ennis Joslin Road.

**BACKGROUND AND FINDINGS:**

Texas A&M University – Corpus Christi (TAMUCC) has conducted a research on the university's presence in the community. As a result of the research, consultants have recommend signage at key areas throughout the City. TAMUCC has reached out to the City for approval of aesthetic painting at the intersection of South Padre Island Drive (SH 357) and Ennis Joslin (Spur 3). Per the existing Municipal Maintenance Agreement (MMA) with the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), the City is allowed to enter into this third-party agreement for surface painting.

This ILA defines TAMUCC's responsibilities as maintaining the painted surfaces as well at the adjacent areas, grounds for termination, graffiti stipulation, and permit costs. TAMUCC will fully fund the aesthetic painting.
