Case No. 0718-04 May Dev, LP: Ordinance rezoning property at or near 7601 South Padre Island Drive and 5246 Lexington Road from "CG-2" General Commercial District to the "IL" Light Industrial District.(3/4 vote required)

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this item is to allow for the construction of an auto sales and service and boat sales and service establishment with service areas.

RECOMMENDATION:

Planning Commission and Staff Recommendation (July 25, 2018):

Denial of the change of zoning from the "CG-2" General Commercial District to the "IL" Light Industrial District, in lieu thereof, approval of the "CG-2/SP" General Commercial District with a Special Permit (SP) with conditions.
