Lease Agreement for Lake Corpus Christi Campground

CAPTION:

Ordinance authorizing a fifteen-year lease agreement with Kamping Pleasures, Inc. for 40 acres out of the Mary B. Kelvin survey in Live Oak County, on the North side of Lake Corpus Christi, in consideration of quarterly rent of \$5,000 or 8% of gross sales, whichever is greater, to operate a campground; with option to extend for up an to additional ten-year term.

PURPOSE:

The Water Utilities Department seeks approval to enter into a fifteen (15) year lease agreement with the Kamping Pleasures, Inc. (Lessee) for the parcel and improvements located on the North side of Lake Corpus Christi off of County Road 3024 on County Rd 371. Also included in this ordinance is an option to extend for an additional ten (10) year term.

BACKGROUND AND FINDINGS:

Kamping Pleasures, Inc. has been leasing 40 acres of City property on Lake Corpus Christi for over 47 years. The Lessee is responsible for all campground improvements and maintenance.

Currently operating under the name of 'Mustang Hollow Campground', the site amenities include tent and RV sites, cabins and cottages, year-round pool, outdoor kitchen, snack bar and wi-fi.
