The CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS, hereinafter referred to as the City, and BasE Security and Fire Consultants, LLC, Rosenburg, Texas, hereinafter referred to as the Contractor, do hereby make and enter into this Amendment No. 6 (the "Amendment") which, together with the Service Agreement No. 830 (the "Agreement") and all other duly executed amendments, constitutes the entire agreement under the above-referenced Service Agreement between the City and the Contractor.

Section 3. Compensation and Payment in the Agreement is hereby amended to increase the hours at the O. N. Stevens Water Treatment Plant for an additional value not to exceed \$208,269.25 for a total value not to exceed \$1,968,755.50.
