

Ordinance authorizing execution of all documents necessary to accept \$216,469.70 grant from State of Texas, Criminal Justice Division for Victims of Crime Act Outreach Program with City match of \$13,637.43 and in-kind match of \$40,480 from Police Grant Fund; appropriating the \$216,469.70 in Police Grants Fund for the VOCA Outreach program; and authorizing transfer of \$13,637.43 from the General Fund to the Police Grants Fund and appropriating the same for total project cost of \$270,587.13.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to accept a grant from the State of Texas, Criminal Justice Division in the amount of \$216,469.70 to continue the Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) Outreach Program within the Police Department with a City match of \$13,637.43 and an in-kind match of \$40,480 from the No. 1020 Police General Fund

SECTION 2. That \$216,469.70 grant is appropriated in the No. 1061 Police Grants Fund to continue the Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) Outreach Program in the Police Department.

SECTION 3. The transfer of \$13,637.43 from the No. 1020 General Fund to the No. 1061 Police Grants Fund as grant matching funds is authorized and appropriated for a total project cost of \$270,587.13.
