Resolution authorizing a six-year service agreement for the purchase of emergency medical and police priority dispatch call center system software from Priority Dispatch Corp., of Salt Lake City, Utah for a total amount not to exceed \$396,260.

WHEREAS, the emergency medical and police priority dispatch call center system software will be purchased for use by both medical and law enforcement personnel;

WHEREAS, this item allows dispatchers to provide the nationally standardized National Academies of Emergency Dispatch protocols for both medical and law enforcement scenarios;

WHEREAS, State law provides that such procurements, as outlined above, are subject to statutory procurement requirements, including competitive bids, unless an exception applies;

WHEREAS, there is a statutory exception for this procurement in Local Government Code, Section 252.022(a) (2), as this purchase is necessary to provide to preserve or protect the public health and safety of the municipality's residents; and

WHEREAS, there is also a statutory exception for this procurement in Local Government Code, Section 252.022(a) (7) (A), as this purchase is available from only one source due to patents, copyrights, secret processes, or natural monopolies.

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Corpus Christi, Texas:

Section 1. The City Council specifically finds that the foregoing statements included in the preamble of this resolution are true and correct and adopts such findings for all intents and purposes related to the authorization of this procurement.

Section 2. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to execute all documents necessary to secure a six-year service agreement with Priority Dispatch Corp., of Salt Lake City, Utah for the purchase of emergency medical and police priority dispatch call center system software, for a total amount not to exceed \$396,260.
