Ordinance appropriating \$4,000,000 from the TIRZ #2 fund for construction of the Park Road 22 Bridge; and approving a developer agreement with Diamond Beach Holdings, LLC and Padre Island Holdings, LLC, which certifies the availability of \$11,696,319.50 for the construction of the Park Road 22 Bridge and requires the award of the construction contract for the bridge after the third-party canal is completed.

WHEREAS, the City desires to move forward with the construction of a bridge project on Park Road 22 (the "Bridge Project");

WHEREAS, the City has previously issued bids associated with the construction of the Bridge Project, but did not award the contract;

WHEREAS, the Developers desire to move forward with the construction of a canal project located to the West / Southwest of the Bridge Project (the "Village Canal"); and

WHEREAS, the City and the Developers desire to coordinate the construction of the Bridge Project with the construction of the Village Canal;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That funds in the amount of \$4,000,000 are appropriated from the TIRZ #2 fund 1111 Restricted Fund Balance.

SECTION 2. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to execute a developer agreement with Diamond Beach Holdings, LLC and Padre Island Holdings, LLC, which certifies the availability of \$11,696,319.50 for the construction of the Park Road 22 Bridge and requires the award of the construction contract for the bridge after the third-party canal is completed. A copy of the **Developer Agreement** is attached to this ordinance.
