Authorizing submission of grant application for \$418,087 to the Automobile Burglary Theft Prevention Authority (ABTPA) to continue the motor vehicle theft enforcement grant with a City cash match of \$702,757, in-kind match of \$62,046, and program income match of \$3,851 for a total project cost of \$1,186,741.
