

Ordinance authorizing the acceptance and appropriation of a grant contract for the Tuberculosis Prevention and Control-State (TB/PC-STATE) grant in the amount of \$61,645.00, from the Texas Department of State Health Services in the Health Grants Fund with a City match of \$12,329.00, to provide tuberculosis prevention and control services September 1, 2019 through August 31, 2020.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Corpus Christi, Texas:

Section 1: The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to accept and appropriate a grant from the Texas Department of State Health Services in the amount of \$61,645.00, for the contract period of September 1, 2019, through August 31, 2020, to provide tuberculosis prevention and control services with a City match of \$12,329.00

Section 2: That the grant in the amount of \$61,645.00, is appropriated in the No. 1066 Health Grants Fund to continue the TB/PC-STATE grant in the Health Department.

Section 3: The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute any future amendments to the grant contract which extend the contract period or increase or decrease the amount of the grant

Section 4: A copy of the executed grants shall be filed in the office of the City Secretary.
