

Ordinance accepting and appropriating \$289,765.00 from the Federal Aviation Administration Grant and authorizing reimbursement of expenses for additional fencing, security cameras and server upgrades/replacements within the airport terminal building as part of the Perimeter Fencing Project and amending the FY2018-2019 Capital Budget.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Funds in the amount of \$289,765 from the Federal Aviation Administration for Amendment No. 1 to Grant No. 3-48-0051-054-2016 are accepted and appropriated in the No. 3020 Airport Capital Improvement Fund for additional fencing, security cameras and server upgrades/replacements within the airport terminal building as part of the Perimeter Fencing Project; and are authorized to reimburse funds initially used for the project.

SECTION 2. The FY2018-2019 Capital Budget adopted by Ordinance No. 031550 is amended by increasing revenues and expenditures by \$289,765 each.
