ORDINANCE AWARDING A CONTRACT TO HAAS-ANDERSON CONSTRUCTION, LTD IN THE AMOUNT OF \$11,016,599.50 FOR CONSTRUCTION OF AYERS STREET PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS AND TURN LANE ADDITION FROM SOUTH PADRE ISLAND DRIVE (SPID) TO GOLLIHAR ROAD FOR THE BASE BID AND ADDITIVE ALTERNATE NO. 1 WITH ASPHALT PAVEMENT; AMENDING THE FY2019 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM BUDGET TO SUPPORT THE USE OF BOND 2014 PROPOSITION 1 FUNDS, INCREASE THE BUDGET, AND FUNDS ARE AVAILABLE IN BOND 2014 STREETS AND VARIOUS UTILITY FUNDS.

WHEREAS, in November 2014, voters approved Bond 2014, Proposition 2, that included the Ayers Street Pedestrian Improvements and Turn Lane Project from SPID to Gollihar ("Project");

WHEREAS, there are funds remaining from Bond 2014, Proposition 1 after making due provision for the Proposition 1 street improvement projects and required funds to complete the Project currently exist within Fund 3551 Street 2015 GO Bond 2014 reserves; and

WHEREAS, the City Council approved the FY 2018 – 2019 Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Budget on its second reading on September 18, 2018, by Ordinance No. 031550;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. City Council supports the use and commitment of necessary funding from Bond 2014, Proposition 1 to be used on Bond 2014, Proposition 2 street improvement projects.

SECTION 2. The FY 2019 Capital Improvement Budget adopted by Ordinance No. 031550 is amended to increase the budget in the amount of \$4,405,715.00 for the Ayers Street Pedestrian Improvements and Turn Lane Project from South Padre Island Drive (SPID) to Gollihar Road.

SECTION 3. The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute a construction contract with Haas-Anderson Construction of Corpus Christi, Texas in the amount of \$11,016,599.50 for the Base Bid and Additive Alternate No. 1 for Ayers Street Pedestrian Improvements and Turn Lane Project from South Padre Island Drive (SPID) to Gollihar Road.
