

ARTS & CULTURAL COMMISSION

Duties

The Arts & Cultural Commission recommends the use, location, lease or purchase of works of art to be considered a part of the beautification or cultural development of the City; to advise owners of private property in relation to beautification of their properties; to prepare specifications for the maintenance of works of art and to inspect such work for the guidance of the City departments concerned; to advise with respect to the design of buildings, bridges or other structures on city property if submitted to the Commission; to study and evaluate the activities in and the uses made of the Bayfront Arts & Science Park, and to plan the Park's development for future activities and uses.

Composition

Nine (9) members appointed by the Mayor subject to confirmation by the Council for three-year terms to provide advice on beautification and cultural development of the City. The Commission shall represent the following categories: (1) Marketing representative (1) Economic Development/Tourism representative; (1) Public Space/Public Art representative; (1) Youth/Education representative; (1) Performing Arts representative; (1) Visual Arts representative; (1) Architecture representative; (1) Higher Education representative; and (1) Business Development Groups/Corporate representative. The Commission may organize and elect a Chairman annually and adopt such administrative procedures as are necessary to accomplish its purposes.

NEW INTERPROFESSIONAL EDUCATION (IPE) PROGRAM DEVELOPMENTS:

Art Rounds: A pilot program that involved the coordination of Rockford University (RU) Nursing, RU Psychology, University of Illinois at Chicago (UIC) Medicine and UIC Pharmacy students in which healthcare students evaluated gallery artwork as though it were a “patient”, and then applied these skills to live standardized patients scenarios. Evaluating artwork assisted future healthcare providers in honing observation and communication skills, creating comfort with ambiguity, and in reducing the development of bias. The Art Rounds project was a powerful tool in teaching and training students for patient analysis and engagement.

Bioterrorism Preparedness Project: RU Nursing student participated in a full-scale bioterrorism simulated experience, focused on community exposure to a biochemical agent, together with RU Psychology, UIC Medicine, UIC Pharmacy students, and Winnebago County employees. Students

experienced this event as healthcare service participants. RU Theater students portrayed exposed patients in the bioterrorism simulation.

Haiti Clinical Experience: RU Nursing students spent a week in Gramothe, Haiti and provided healthcare services in the areas of triage, lab analysis, pharmacy, and in the Haitian clinic with RU Nursing Faculty, Nurse Practitioners, Doctors, Pharmacists and Creole language translators.

Interprofessional Education (IPE) Simulation with SwedishAmerican Hospital (SAH): RU Nursing and UIC Medicine students performed simulations involving a high-fidelity manikin that simulated labor and delivery, infant delivery with shoulder dystocia, postpartum hemorrhaging, and other various obstetrical emergencies.

IPE Leader to Leader Mentorship Program: The Leader-to-Leader Mentorship Program was a partnership with Rockford School District 205, RU Nursing, and UIC Medicine to link Jefferson High School freshmen students with student mentors from RU Nursing and UIC Medicine. The purpose was to inspire the interest of high school students (particularly those who are considered at risk or are underrepresented) to pursue higher education or post-high school career training.

IPE Day: In collaboration with UIC Colleges of Medicine and Pharmacy and RU Nursing, more than 200 students participated in various collaborative interprofessional education simulations. RU Theater students also participated as Standardized Patients in a simulated hospital discharge setting.
