# LOCAL PREFERENCE COUNCIL POLICY

- Council Policy— Hire Corpus Christi First
  - ✓ Allows a local preference
  - ✓ Must comply with State Law
  - Economic Advantage must be proven
  - ✓ Business in Corpus must be substantial not a front





#### LOCAL PREFERENCE STATE LAW

- > Texas Local Government Code 271.901 -
  - ✓ Must select the local bidder if:
    - Two or more bidders have bids identical in nature and amount, and
    - One of the two is local
- > Texas Government Code 2252 -
  - ✓ Lowest bidder is out of state
  - ✓ State of the lowest bidder has a local preference
  - ✓ Must apply that same preference against the lowest bidder



## LOCAL PREFERENCE STATE LAW 3% Rule and 5% Rules

## Texas Local Government Code 271.905:

- Allowed for goods only
- Local Bid is within 3% of lowest bid price received
- May contract with either lowest bidder, or
- Local bidder if economic advantage is proven

## Texas Local Government Code 271.9051:

- Allowed for goods up to \$500k and construction up to \$100k
- Local Bid is within 5% of lowest bid price received
- May contract with either lowest bidder, or
- Local bidder if economic advantage is proven



- Cannot apply if using Federal Funding
- Discourages out of town vendors thereby decreasing competition
- Increases the cost of projects if applied
- Slows down the award process while vetting the claimed economic advantage
- May create protests if the economic benefit is not proven
