The Historic Preservation Plan Update will:

- Promote heritage tourism, preservation-based economic development, and heritage education
- Assess historic preservation as an urban design strategy
- Recommend updates to the Unified Development Code and provide toolkits for substantial rehabilitation, including but not limited to economic and regulatory incentives.
