**WHEREAS**, with proper notice to the public, a public hearing was held during a meeting of the Planning Commission during which all interested persons were allowed to be heard;

**WHEREAS**, the Planning Commission has forwarded to the City Council its final report and recommendation regarding the application for an amendment to the City of Corpus Christi's Unified Development Code ("UDC") and corresponding UDC Zoning Map;

**WHEREAS**, with proper notice to the public, a public hearing was held during a meeting of the City Council, during which all interested persons were allowed to be heard;

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has determined that this rezoning is not detrimental to the public health, safety, or general welfare of the City of Corpus Christi and its citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that this rezoning will promote the best and most orderly development of the properties affected thereby, and to be affected thereby, in the City of Corpus Christi.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The Unified Development Code ("UDC") and corresponding UDC Zoning Map of the City of Corpus Christi, Texas is amended by changing the zoning on the subject property described as being 80.144 acre tract of land situated in the Enriquez Villareal Survey Abstract No. 1, Nueces County, Texas, and being all of the south half of Block 2 of the J.C. Russell Farm Blocks, 27.361 acre tract of land situated in the Enriquez Villareal Survey Abstract No. 1, Nueces County, Texas, and being a portion of Lots 14, 17 & 18 and all of Lots 22, 25 & 26 of the Johnny C. Wilson Farm Lots, 9.192 acre tract of land situated in the Enriquez Villareal Survey Abstract No. 1, Nueces County, Texas, and being a portion of Lots 2, 6 & 10 of the Johnny C. Wilson Farm Lots, 0.192 acre tract of land situated in the Enriquez Villareal Survey Abstract No. 1, Nueces County, Texas, and being a portion of Lot 2 of the Johnny C. Wilson Farm Lots, 98.382 acre tract of land situated in and Enriquez Villareal Survey Abstract No. 1, Nueces County, Texas, and being all of the north half of Block 2 of the J.C. Russell Farm Blocks, 5.380 acre tract of land situated in and Enriquez Villareal Survey Abstract No. 1, Nueces County, Texas, and being all of Lot 21 of the Johnny C. Wilson Farm Lots, 9.072 acre tract of land situated in and Enriquez Villareal Survey Abstract No. 1, Nueces County, Texas, and being a portion of Lots 3, 4, 7 & 8 of the Johnny C. Wilson Farm Lots as shown in Exhibit "A":

from the "FR" Farm Rural District and "IL" Light Industrial District to the "IL" Light Industrial District.

The subject property is located at or near 501 Heinsohn Road. Exhibit A, which is a map of the subject property attached to and incorporated in this ordinance.

**SECTION 2.** The UDC and corresponding UDC Zoning Map of the City, made effective July 1, 2011 and as amended from time to time, except as changed by this ordinance, both remain in full force and effect including the penalties for violations as made and provided for in Article 10 of the UDC.

**SECTION 3.** To the extent this amendment to the UDC represents a deviation from the City's Comprehensive Plan, the Comprehensive Plan is amended to conform to the UDC, as it is amended by this ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances specifically pertaining to the zoning of the subject property that are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby expressly repealed.

**SECTION 5.** A violation of this ordinance, or requirements implemented under this ordinance, constitutes an offense punishable as provided in Article 1, Section 1.10.1 of the UDC, Article 10 of the UDC, and/or Section 1-6 of the Corpus Christi Code of Ordinances.

**SECTION 6.** Publication shall be made in the official publication of the City of Corpus Christi as required by the City Charter of the City of Corpus Christi.

**SECTION 7.** This ordinance shall become effective upon publication.
