

LAKE CORPUS CHRISTI


60.9% level capacity

# Our Responsibility







As a regional water supplier, the City of Corpus Christi is required to have our plan adhere to Title 30 of the Texas Administrative Code, Chapter 288.



Water management is critical in order to meet our regional water demands. A Water Conservation Plan is a playbook for inclusive accountability in a region that has limited water supply resources.



All our municipal water users and our wholesale providers in the Coastal Bend are included in conservation and drought contingency planning.
