Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Corpus Christi, Texas:

SECTION 1. The City Council authorizes submission of five grant applications to the Texas General Land Office for Community Development Block Grant-MIT 2015 Floods and Hurricane Harvey State Mitigation Competition funds. The applications are for five projects: Downtown Pump Stations/Drainage Improvements, Back Up Generators for Corpus Christi Wastewater Infrastructure, Greenwood Flood Mitigation and Emergency Generator, Oso Creek Bottom Rectification, and Williams Ditch/Oso Bay Basin Flood Mitigation.

SECTION 2. The City of Corpus Christi agrees to provide applicable matching funds of 1% for the said projects, with the understanding that Oso Creek Bottom Rectification project does not require matching funds.

SECTION 3: City Manager or the City Manager's designee may apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant.
