Resolution authorizing a total of up to \$3,838.50 from the City's Coronavirus Relief Fund allocation through the CARES Act to Corpus Christi Montessori School to provide funds for up to 25% of the cost to purchase the computer equipment necessary to facilitate compliance with COVID-19 related public health measures and tele-learning.

WHEREAS, the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act established the Coronavirus Relief Fund (CRF), which fund is administered by the Texas Department of Emergency Management and from which the City of Corpus Christi ("City") has received an allocation; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to make a portion of its CRF allocation available for the benefit of its citizens in Corpus Christi Montessori School for the purchase of computer equipment necessary to facilitate compliance with COVID-19 related public health measures and tele-learning.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS, THAT:

The City Council authorizes the City Manager, or his designee, to execute all documents necessary to bind the City to provide a total of up to \$3,838.50 from the City's CRF allocation, through the CARES Act, to Corpus Christi Montessori School for the purchase of computer equipment necessary to facilitate compliance with COVID-19 related public health measures and tele-learning, for the purpose stated.
