

Resolution authorizing a five-year service agreement with Area Electronics Systems, Inc., dba DataON, in an amount not to exceed \$74,010.50 for the purchase data storage, application servers, and warranty for the Cefe Valenzuela Landfill and J.C. Elliott Collection Center, effective upon issuance of a notice to proceed, with FY 2021 funding available through the General Fund.

WHEREAS, State law provides that such procurements, as outlined above, are subject to statutory procurement requirements, including competitive bids, unless an exception applies;

WHEREAS, there is a statutory exception for this procurement in Local Government Code, Section 252.022(a) (2), as this purchase is necessary to provide to preserve or protect the public health and safety of the municipality's residents; and

WHEREAS, there is a statutory exception for this procurement in Local Government Code, Section 252.022(a) (7) (A), as this purchase is available from only one source due to special processes or patents.

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Corpus Christi, Texas:

Section 1. The City Council specifically finds that the foregoing statements included in the preamble of this resolution are true and correct and adopt such findings for all intents and purposes related to the authorization of this procurement.

Section 2. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to execute all documents necessary to secure a five-year service agreement with Area Electronics Systems, Inc., dba DataON, in an amount not to exceed \$74,010.50 for Azure Stack Hyper-Converged Infrastructure (HCI).
