

Ordinance appropriating Federal Aviation Administration Grants #63 and 64 totaling \$2,667,902 pursuant to the federal Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act for economic relief to eligible U.S. airports affected by the prevention of, preparation for, and response to the COVID-19 pandemic; and amending the FY 2020-2021 Operating Budget by increasing revenues and expenditures.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Grants #63 (3-48-0051-063-2021; \$2,597,630) and #64 (3-48-0051-064-2021; \$70,272) totaling \$2,667,902 from the Federal Aviation Administration, awarded pursuant to the federal Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act for economic relief to eligible U.S. airports affected by the prevention of, preparation for, and response to the COVID-19 pandemic, are appropriated in the No. 1055 Airport Grants Fund.

SECTION 2. The FY 2020-2021 Operating and Capital Budget, adopted by Ordinance No. 032203, is amended by increasing both revenues and expenditures in the amount of \$2,667,902.
