Del Mar College Process Technology II

- Addition to the Process Technology plant
- Grant: \$2,356,000 approved by City Council in August 2018
- Have received all equipment
- Grant paid: \$1,649,505
- Grant remaining: \$757,495
- Expires: 08/21/23
- Should be operational this year





International Consulting Engineers (ICE)

- Engineering firm
- Grant: \$125,000 approved by City Council May 2018
- Grant paid: \$50,000
- Grant remaining: \$75,000
- Expires: 05/12/23
- The construction is complete





Texas A&M University – Corpus Christi Industrial and Civil Engineering

- Build out laboratory spaces for these two new engineering curricula
- Grant: \$2,000,000
- Amended in August 2018 to extend the time by two years since it was not funded by the legislature and there was a delay with the Higher Education Board approval
- Approved for both programs by Higher Education Board
- Grant paid: \$313,877
- Grant remaining: \$1,686,122
- Expires: 12/31/23
- Already have students in both curricula
- Should be expensed in the next two years





LaVista Pointe (this is a Type B grant)

- Infrastructure improvement on North Beach for apartment complex
 - Grant: \$625,000
 - Construction has begun, all permits have been acquired
 - Construction should be complete Q3 of 2021
 - Grant paid: \$0
 - Grant remaining: \$625,000
 - Expires: 11/27/23

LiftFund Interest Buy-Down Program

- Micro lender
- Grant: \$150,000 for the fiscal year
- Grant paid: \$8,040.93
- Grant remaining: \$141,959.07
- Expires September 30, 2021

Service Corps of Retired Executives (SCORE)

- Provides counseling and workshop training for small businesses
- Grant: \$54,000 for the fiscal year
- Grant paid: \$35,632.44
- Grant remaining: \$18,367.56
- Expires September 30, 2021
- Did 3,351 hours of counselling, had 54 workshops and 2,448 attendees



Del Mar College Intern

- Help small businesses by providing student interns. These students work in their major area of study, the Type A fund pays an extra \$5.00/hour in addition to the hourly wage paid by the business
- Grant : \$100,000 for the calendar year
- Grant paid: \$7,618.30
- Grant remaining: \$92,381.70
- Expires: December 31, 2021

Texas A&M University – Corpus Christi Intern

- Help small businesses by providing student interns. These students work in their major area of study, the Type A fund pays an extra \$5.00/hour in addition to the hourly wage paid by the business
- Grant : \$150,000 for the calendar year
- Grant paid: \$42,756.32
- Grant remaining: \$107,243.68
- Expires: December 31, 2021



Del Mar College PTAC Procurement Technical Assistance Center

- Help small businesses qualify for, bid, and perform on procurement contracts with all levels of government
- Grant approved for calendar year 2021: \$99,000
- Grant paid: \$40,925.29
- Grant remaining: \$58,574.71
- Expires: December 31, 2021



Del Mar College CRC Contract Resource Center

- Help small businesses qualify for, bid, and perform on procurement contracts with large private companies in the area
- Grant approved for calendar year 2021: \$133,000
- Grant paid: \$47,912.53
- Grant remaining: \$85,087.47
- Expires: December 31, 2021
