3. <u>22-1706</u> Capital Improvement Projects

Mr. Atwood had no update on the Corps of Engineers permit for the dock construction project. Mr. Kelley questioned what would happen if the new bid for the project comes in higher than the amount previously approved. Parks and Recreation assistant director Kevin Johnson advised the project would not be scaled back, we would use other avenues to find the additional monies. Mr. Atwood attended a scoping meeting for the Coopers Alley boaters facility on September 30th with the selected design firm and another scoping meeting for the Coopers Alley haul out facility on October 3rd. The Peoples Street boardwalk project was approved by City Council and the design firm selection is in progress.
