Marina Manager Jonathan Atwood advised we are preparing for an influx of crowds during spring break, March 10th through 21st.

Mr. Atwood updated the committee on the department's Capital Improvement

Projects. Bellingham Marine assembled L pier and has it temporarily at the end of A and B piers. Callan Marine is still dredging behind the yacht club and will need to dredge by MORF pier and the bulkhead. Once dredging behind the yacht club is complete crew will float L pier into place and install it. CCW and Engineering are finalizing the project to replace the main water and sewage lines on Coopers Alley L Head which will allow us to move forward with the Coopers Alley Boaters Facility and Haul Out Facility projects. Mr. Atwood expects demolition on the Coopers Alley boater's facility to begin late this summer or early fall. SR Trident began driving new piles and will hopefully be finished with the Peoples Street boardwalk by early summer.
