**Title:** Executive Session pursuant to Texas Government Code § 551.071 and Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct Rule 1.05 to consult with attorneys concerning legal issues related to the purchase, exchange, lease, or value of real property rights for desalination and water treatment, transmission, and storage facilities, including areas at or near the (1) the Inner Harbor Ship Channel Seawater Desalination Site at or in the vicinity of Nueces Bay Blvd, Summers St., Palm Dr., John St., and Broadway Street, Nueces Bay Heights Subdivision, Sunset Place Subdivision, and the Industrial Canal and (2) the La Quinta Channel Seawater Desalination Site involving various properties between Highway 361 and the La Quinta Ship Channel and areas in and adjacent to said locations, (3) other water rights and contracts for the purchase of water including, but not limited to, water related permits on or near the Colorado River, Waldron Road, Laguna Madre, Oso Bay, and/or the Mary Rhodes Pipeline, (4) applications for water rights permits, discharge permits, and other permits from the Texas Commission of Environmental Quality and/or the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, and (5) potential use of eminent domain proceedings to effectuate the aforementioned acquisitions and pursuant to Texas Government Code § 551.072 to deliberate the purchase, exchange, lease, or value of real property (including, but not limited to, property (water) rights at or in the vicinity of the aforementioned locations) because deliberation in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the position of the governmental body in negotiations with a third person.
